

Tram Hall in the new (Munich Transport) "MVG Museum"

This previous industrial hall, over 5000 m² in size (nearly 54,000 sq feet), once part of the main tram workshop of the Munich Transport Group, is now home to the new ,MVG Museum'. It documents the over 130-year old history of Munich's public transportation system. At the same time, a uniquely new event and exhibition location emerged in this high quality renovated, landmarked building.

Already back in 1918 the complex acted as a warfare metal plant in Southeastern Munich. From the 1920s it was used as a main workshop for the Munich public transportation operations. The steel and metal construction of the hall, with two vertical pillars, give the room a clear symmetry. The elaborate glass facade and skylights create extraordinary lighting accents.









The Entrance Hall

The well-lit entrance area has the character of a large workshop cathedral of the early 20th century. Discreet colors and materials underline the extraordinary architecture.

The galleries and walkable bridges give this room very original design and layout options for your event with several hundred guests.

This can be an exhibit, an anniversary or a Christmas party with your employess, a wedding with a reception on the spacious terrace, seminars, conferences or other. The best part of all: you can ride with your guests on a historical tram from Munich's city center directly into the building.




The Hall

The central focal point of the room are two parallel tracks, 110 meters in length. Displayed on them are antique trams from the 130-year transportation history. The white-blue (Bavarian colors) tram ensemble is complemented by additional antique work vehicles and Munich busses, an original U-Bahn (subway) head train and a U-Bahn ride simulator.

To add to the special atmosphere historical tram and bus stops, user-friendly technical and network exhibits and an inspection pit have been included.

Depending on the space needed the guests may move inbetween or in parts of the exhibit during their event. The hall alone can serve up to 750 guests.
